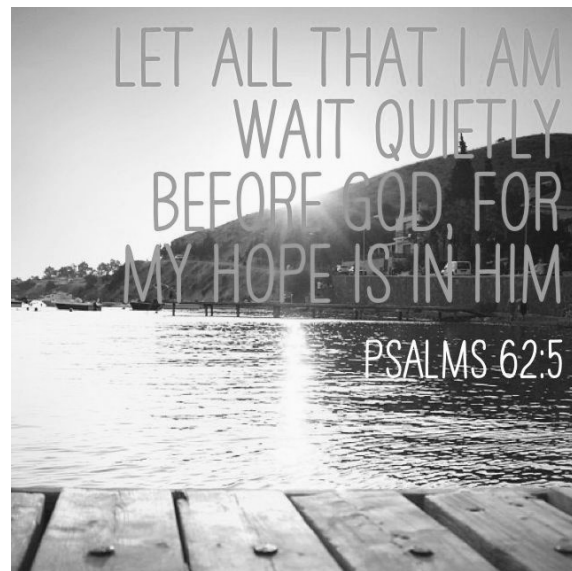
Psalm 62:5-8

CHURCH UPDATES

At the last Administrative Board meeting, the following was decided for the month of October:

We will continue to worship in the Discipleship Center at 10:00 a.m., with a live stream on FaceBook. Safety measures are still in place, including masks, social distancing, and use of hand sanitizer.

We will continue to have two songs in the service. The first will be sung by the praise band. The second, after the sermon and first dismissal, can be sung by everyone downstairs who is comfortable singing. The upstairs will be reserved for those who do not wish to be near singers.

We will offer two dismissals. The first will be immediately following the sermon and prayer, and is for people who do not wish to be inside during singing. The second will be after our congregational song for everyone.

Each week, we will alternate singing traditional and contemporary songs.
